Tattoo removal with our advanced medical-grade Q-Switched Nd:YAG laser

Laser Tattoo Removal is a safe and effective treatment designed to progressively fade and remove unwanted tattoos. Using advanced laser technology, short bursts of light energy are delivered into the tattoo pigment, causing the ink particles to rapidly heat and shatter into smaller fragments. These fragments are then naturally cleared away by the body's immune system over time. The treatment can be used for complete tattoo removal or to lighten existing tattoos in preparation for a cover-up.

BENEFITS

Reduces the appearance of unwanted tattoos by progressively fading ink

Can be used to lighten tattoos prior to cover-up work

Suitable for a range of tattoo sizes and ink colours

Recommended *Treatment Plan.*

The number of treatments required varies depending on factors such as the tattoo's size, colour, depth of ink, location and your skin type. Some tattoos may show significant fading after as few as 6 treatments, while others may require 6–12 sessions or more for optimal clearance. Most clients notice progressive lightening after each treatment session. During your consultation, your clinician will create a personalised treatment plan based on your individual tattoo and desired outcome.

RECOVERY TIME

Following laser tattoo removal, it is normal to experience temporary redness, swelling, warmth, and mild tenderness in the treated area immediately after the session. The skin may also appear slightly raised or develop a "frosting" effect for a short period as the ink breaks down. Most clients can return to normal daily activities straight after treatment, however the skin will continue to heal over the following days. Small scabs, crusting, or blistering may occur as part of the natural healing process and typically resolve within 5–10 days, depending on the size, colour, and density of the tattoo.

During the healing period, it is important to avoid heat-based activities such as saunas, steam rooms, hot showers, and intense exercise that causes excessive sweating for at least 48–72 hours, as heat can increase inflammation and delay healing. You should also avoid swimming (including pools, spas, and the ocean) until the skin has fully healed and any scabs or broken skin have resolved, typically around 7–10 days.

Keep the area clean, dry, and protected, and avoid picking, scratching, or rubbing the treated skin. Direct sun exposure should also be avoided, and an SPF30-50+ should be used once the skin has healed to help protect the area and support optimal results.

To help you achieve the best possible results, your clinician will guide you through any required aftercare before your treatment. Comprehensive aftercare information can also be provided ahead of your appointment if desired.
